The Transportation Electrification Roadmap (TER) is the District's encompassing plan regarding electrification of the transportation sector. The TER provides guidance to meeting the three overarching transportation goals of the Clean Energy DC Omnibus Act of 2018:

Federal tax incentives of up to \$7,500 are still available for District residents and private fleet owners. An updated list of eligible vehicle make and models is available.

The cost and logistics of charging an electric vehicle is an important consideration for residents and businesses in making a decision to purchase an EV or install charging infrastructure. Fortunately, resources are available to help offset this cost through Pepco EVsmart program. Get more information about Pepco's EVsmart program.

A new electric vehicle, other than a motorcycle and motorized bicycle, is eligible for a reduced vehicle registration fee of \$36. This reduced rate applies to the first two years of registration after which the vehicle shall be treated as a Class I, Class II, or Class III, Class IV, whichever is applicable.

Fast charge your EV at one of 40+ EVgo charging stations in the capitol of the United States. This includes EV charging stations within the Washington D.C. city limits, Loudon County, Montgomery County, Prince George's County, Fairfax, Charles, Arlington, and Washington County.

To begin, open your EV's charge port and from the charger choose the appropriate connector. Plug your connector into the charge port until it clicks firmly into place. (*Click!*)
