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Beddagana Wetland Park is the perfect place to visit in Colombo to immerse in nature away from city hustle and bustle. It is a hidden germ worthy a visit to enjoy serene environment and unique experience.

The Beddagana wetland park sits on a 18 hectares and is a green oasis where visitors get to enjoy views amazing views, see wildlife and learn about conservation of wetlands.

If you love bird watching then you should visit this park because you will get to see different bird species especially during the migratory birds' season.

Throughout the year you can visit the park and get to see various birds in the park which is filled with small tress and water reservoir. The best spot to see most of these birds is around the water body.

More so you will also learn about conservation. The learning starts here because you are not required to enter the park with plastic bottles and containers. If you have them you are required to leave at the ticketing counter and pick when leaving the park.

The Beddagana wetland park is home of several wildlife. The park is perfect place where you can get see animals like fishing cats, water monitors, porcupines, and civets.

There are several observation spots in the park where visitors are allowed to hide or trail the wildlife. If you are wildlife lover you should not miss the chance to view some animals in this park.

You can get stunning views in the park when you get to various attractions which include butterfly garden, bird tower, boardwalk, lotus pond and floating deck. You can also catch the sunrise and sunset views from the park.

The park is open though out the year and you can choose when to visit based on your preferences. The best time to visit the park and see the migratory birds is from November to February.

For great scenery views best time to visit the park is from March to April during dry season. There are more butterflies and flowers in the park. It is also best time to enjoy the sunrise or sunset.

The park is 15 km away from Colombo city and you can hire a taxi to get there. The drive will be around 45 minutes. It is the fastest and comfortable means you can use to reach the park.

You can also take tuk-tuk to get to the park from anywhere in Colombo. The tuk-tuk is slow and it will take



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you around 1 hour to get there. If you don't mind the noise and bumpy ride you can take tuk-tuk because it cheaper compared to taxi.

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
