The residential electricity price in the United Arab Emirates is AED 0.293 per kWh or USD 0.080. The electricity price for businesses is AED 0.405 kWh or USD 0.110. These retail prices were collected in March 2024 and include the cost of power, distribution and transmission, and all taxes and fees.

These are retail (pump) level prices, including all taxes and fees. The information is updated weekly. The next table shows the electricity rates per kWh.

Fuel surcharge are calculated based on electricity consumption (Fils/kWh) & water consumption (Fils/IG) and included in the monthly bill. Fuel surcharge vary based on increase or decrease in fuel prices supplied to DEWA generation plants.
